Thesis	0-1 points Vague or absent thesis statement, unrelated to the body of the essay	2-3 points Imprecise Thesis Statement but related to the essay	4-5 points Specific and clear thesis statement related to the assignment
Sources	0-10 points Sources used are not appropriate (ie unapproved internet sources) or too few to support the argument, contains few or no references to the sources, no bibliography	11-18 points Uses primary and secondary sources but they are less than required or do not adequately support the argument/contains references and bibliography but does not use Chicago Style	19-20 points Demonstrates command over the use of primary and secondary sources and correct Chicago-Style formatting for notes and bibliography
Narrative	0-10 points Analysis relies on description of the sources rather than a specific object, misses most of the key evaluation criteria or is superficial.	11-18 points Analysis engages with world history through the lens of the object, lacks sufficient evidence to support the argument.	19-20 points Narrative demonstrates the use of an object as a specific lens to study world history
Organization and Style	0-9 points Writing is not clear and at times confusing or hard to follow. Transitions are awkward. Missing or incorrect quotations.	10-13 points Writing is generally clear and concise but has some awkward or confusing sections. Transitions are generally smooth. Quotations are not properly contextualized	14-15 points Writing is clear and concise. Quotations are properly contextualized and transitions are smooth. Strong introduction and conclusion
Technology	0-1 points Choice and/or use of technology does not support the narrative, digital skill needs improvement	2-3 points Choice/use of technology adequately supports narrative, shows intermediate digital skill	4-5 points Choice and use of technology exceptional, shows mastery of digital skill
Grammar/Mechanics	0-9 points Numerous spelling or grammatical errors. Informal or passive voice throughout	10-13 points Some spelling or grammatical errors that take away from the argument	14-15 points Few spelling or grammatical errors.
